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- Papers must be no longer than 30 typed double-spaced pages (excluding the 300-word abstract) of 11-point text (Garamond is preferred) with 1-inch margins. This includes all text, tables, figures, endnotes, and references. Endnotes and references are to be placed at the end of the manuscript. Papers over this limit may be returned to the author(s) at the editor's discretion.
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- Define all acronyms at first mention and thereafter use the acronym: Do not alternate. Avoid beginning a sentence with an acronym.
