## Dear Madam:

This is in response to your request of June 23, 2005, regarding your organization's name change.

Based upon the information submitted in your June 23<sup>rd</sup> correspondence (i.e., amendment to your organizing document and minutes of the meeting where the amendment was ratified), the name of your organization has been changed from Industrial Relations Research Association to Labor and Employment Relations Association, as you requested.

For your records, in January 1965 we issued a determination letter that recognized your organization as exempt from federal income tax.
